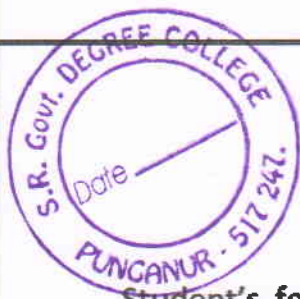

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Feedback report from stake holders

IQAC - 2022-23

1. Students Feedback on Curriculum

Student's feedback on curriculum was collected in online mode using Google forms on a regular basis. A questionnaire (Google form) was given to students which comprises of fourteen questions on a 5 point rating scale (I stands for POOR, II stands for AVERAGE, III for GOOD, IV for VERY GOOD and V for EXCELLENT). A total number of 124 students has participated in the survey and has recorded their feedback. The following report is based on their responses.

More than half the students asserted that the fulfillment of the designed objectives, coverage of fundamentals, the depth of course content, skill promotion in practical classes, learning values in terms of skills, concepts, knowledge, analytical abilities, curriculum's applicability & relevance to real life, interaction with faculty, references suggested, internal assessment, relevance of additional source material in library and timely changes in the content of the course of the curriculum as **excellent**. More than 40% of the students stated that the curriculum's extent of coverage of course, relevance of subject with practical work and ICT based teaching as **excellent**.

One third of the students rated that the curriculum's coverage of fundamentals, depth of course content, coverage of course, ICT based learning and relevance of additional source material as **very good**.

More than 5% of the students stated that the curriculum's depth of course content, skill promotion in practical classes, learning values in terms of knowledge, skills, concepts, analytical abilities, ICT based learning resources and timely changes in the content of the course as **average**. 12% of the students expressed that there is a **need to develop** relevance of the subject with practical classes. A **very few** students opined that there is a **need to improve** curriculum's extent of coverage of course, skill promotion in practical classes, relevance to real life, ICT based learning resources, references suggested, relevance of additional source material and timely changes in the content of the course.

2. Alumni Feedback:

A feedback on the institution and academic ambience from alumni was collected in online mode using Google forms every year on a regular basis. A questionnaire was given to alumni which comprises of 10 questions on a 5 point rating scale i.e., **excellent, very good, good, average** and **poor**. A total number of 79 alumni has participated in the survey and gave their responses. The following report is based on their responses.

More than 60% of the alumni asserted that learning environment, curricular and teaching methods as excellent. More than half of the alumni stated that co-curricular activities, extra-curricular activities, quality of support material and faculty as excellent. About 40% of the alumni expressed that infrastructure & lab facilities, Trainings, placements, fee structure and library as excellent.

About 25% of the alumni opined that infrastructure & lab facilities, teaching methods, co-curricular activities, extra-curricular activities, faculty and quality of support material, fee structure and library as very good. About 25% of alumni expressed that infrastructure and lab facilities, trainings, placements, fee structure and library as good. Below 10% of the alumni stated that infrastructure and lab facilities, co-curricular activities, extra-curricular activities, quality of support material, trainings, placements, fee structure and library as average.

15% stated that there is a need to improve in trainings and placements and a few alumni expressed that there is a need to improve infrastructure, lab facilities, co-curricular activities, extra-curricular activities, faculty and quality of support material, fee structure and library.

3. Teachers feedback on curriculum:

The college follows the prescribed syllabus of the affiliating university in its curriculum. As the teachers are the pivotal stakeholders, teacher's feedback on curriculum was collected every year on a regular basis. For the year 2021-22 teachers' feedback was collected in online mode using Google forms. A questionnaire (Google form) was given to teachers which comprises of ten questions on a **5 point** rating scale i.e., **excellent, very good, good, average** and **need to be improved**. All the 15 teachers on rolls have attempted the survey and gave their valuable feedback. The following analysis is based on their responses.

Two third of the teachers asserted that the curriculum provides freedom to adopt new techniques such as seminar presentations, group discussions and learner's anticipations as excellent. More than half of the teachers affirmed that the curriculum

is suitable to the course, need based, has good balance between theory and practical, has created interest, reference materials are relevant and appropriate, examinations covered all units of syllabus, provides freedom to organize guest lecturers & to assign study projects within the curriculum and overall opinion on the curriculum as **excellent**. **One-third** of the teachers opined that the connectivity in the title of the paper and content, sufficient number of optional papers in the course and freedom in adopting new techniques of testing as **excellent**. A good number of teachers said that the syllabus has increases their knowledge in the subject as good.

A few teachers stated that the syllabus is suitable to the course & need based, connectivity of the title of the paper and content, balance between theory and practical, has created interest in the subject, program carries sufficient number of optional papers, reference material suggested are appropriate, examinations cover all the units in the syllabus, provides a freedom to adopt new strategies for assessment & to assign study projects within the curriculum and overall opinion on the curriculum as **good**. About **10%** of teachers expressed that there are sufficient optional papers and coverage of syllabus in all units in examinations as **average**. Hence it is deduced that majority of the teachers overall opinion on the curriculum is very good.

4. Parents Feedback on Curriculum:

Parents are the distinguished stake holders of the institution. Hence feedback on the institution and academic ambience is collected from them in online mode using Google forms. Parents were given a Google form questionnaire consisting of 10 questions and were asked to respond to the questions on a two point rating scale **Yes/ No**. A total 71 parents has participated in the survey and answered the questions. The following is the brief report of the responses recorded by them.

All the parents are asserted that their son/daughter's progress are being informed and are contended with the assessment, discipline and co-curricular activities. About **95%** of the parents are contended with ICT based teaching, extra - curricular activities like NSS and NCC, sports, games and cultural activities. About **10%** of the parents said that they have no idea about the JKC and skill development in the college. Only a **few** parents expressed that there is a need to improve the quality of education, ICT based teaching, assessment, discipline, extra-curricular activities and certificate courses of the college.

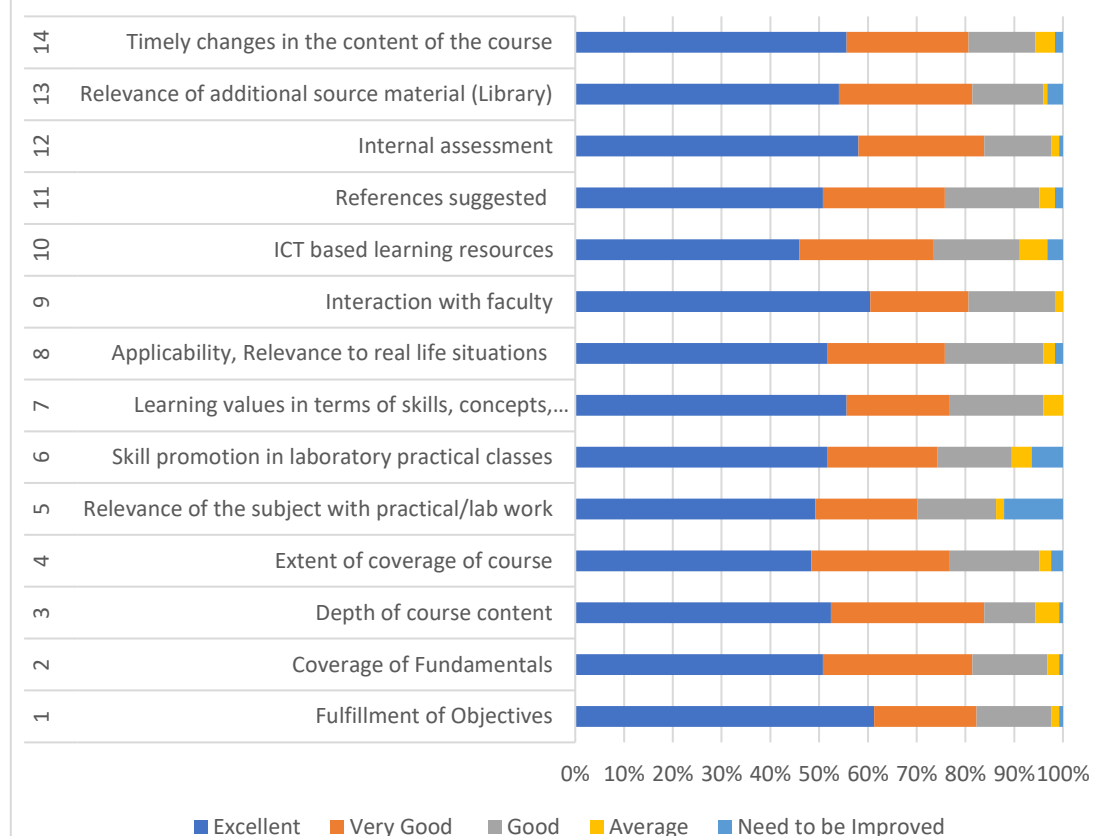

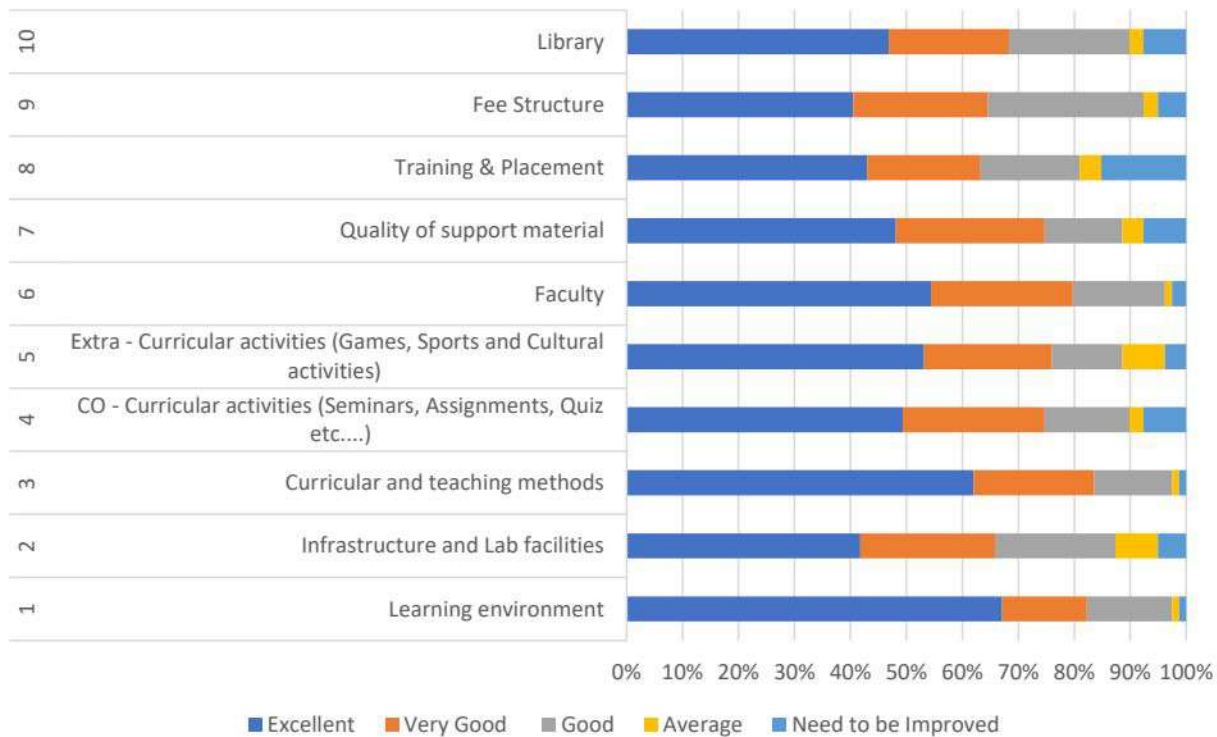

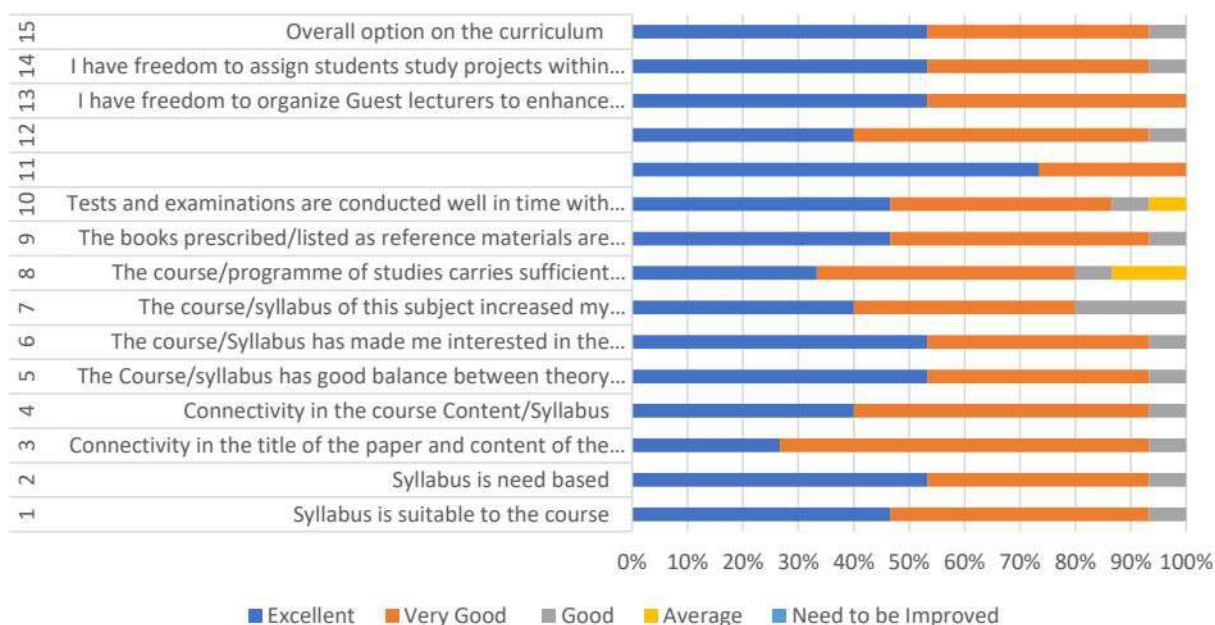
